

Herd Immunity





Distribute the balls with one in each hole. Gold balls are vaccinated individuals; white balls are unvaccinated. The blue ball is Patient Zero. Push down the blue ball.

"Infect" adjacent (up, down, left, right) unvaccinated individuals by pushing them down their holes. Repeat infection step for all infected individuals until there are no more unvaccinated individuals adjacent to infected individuals

Mess Around

Change how close individuals should be to be infected, like also including diagonals. Do more people get infected?
